

Cairns Golf Club Lightning Policy

Ubimet is used by Proshop staff to view lightning strikes in the region.

If a lightning strike occurs within 10kms of the golf club, staff sound the siren three (3) times to suspend play.

A staff member will then go out on course to double check and inform golfers that play is suspended.

After thirty (30) minutes without lightning activity within 10kms, staff sound the siren once to resume play.

If players do not wish to return to the course to finish a competition round, they may submit a partial card for handicapping or alternatively notify shop staff of their intentions & receive a 'No Score – Approved'.

Players who do not return to play or notify staff of their intentions will receive a 'No Score – Not Approved'.

The policy is used in accordance with the rules of golf, adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club (R&A).
